




Kindergarten Learning Grid- Term 3, Week 1

Morning Literacy	<p>Practise writing the letters and sounds we know. We know these sounds: m, a, t, s, i, d, f, n, p, o, r, g, e, h, k, c, u, b</p> <p>Try using coloured pencils, water, paint, sand tray, in the dirt, playdough, turn the lights off and write it in the air with a torch.</p>	<p>We have been learning our special sight words. Can you practise these words: A, a, is, has, the, to, look, he, she, you, no, have, was, his, see, go</p> <p>Try using paint, cut letters from magazines to make the word, write in a sand tray, use different colours to write your words and make with playdough.</p>	<p>Making words: Make some words with the sounds we know, eg: s/a/t = sat. Write these words out on paper and pick a word to write in a sentence.</p> 	<p>Read or listen to a story/stories from home.</p> <p>Look at the front cover. Guess what will happen and draw a picture. Tell someone in your house about your favourite part of the story. Make some puppets to retell the story.</p>
Mid-Morning Numeracy	<p>Numbers: Revise your numbers to 20 and write number 1-20 on cards. Flip a number card. What is the number? Write it in rainbow colours. Flip two cards and count on from the biggest number to add the numbers together.</p> 	<p>Sorting: Sort your lego or building blocks into groups according to: Size Shape Colour Number of sides.</p> <p>Talk to someone in your house about how you have sorted these items.</p> 	<p>Subitise: Listen to the song 'Subitise': https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ib5Gf3GlzAg</p> <p>Pick a number and represent it in as many ways as you can (tally marks, dice, ten frame, dots, fingers).</p>	<p>Shapes: Make a picture using different 2D shapes. Draw your picture and name the shapes you have used. Count how many of each shape you have used and write the total.</p>
