Hello Everyone and welcome to Summer!

To start this week's Newsletter I'd like to go through a couple of reminders in response to the several complaints/enquiries from parents and community members, Firstly, parking in and around the school. There is limited parking on de Chair Avenue and limited parking on Burns Rd. There are many signs displaying where you can and can't park. Please do not park in people's driveways or in front of their driveways. The de Chair Avenue school car park is for staff, deliveries, emergency services and taxi transport for our students in the support unit. There are two disabled parking spots that are for short term parking only and only for the abovementioned people. There is plenty of parking in the Burns Road parent car park which involves a one minute walk to the nearest school gate. Secondly, the 40km/h zone is not just for Macquarie Rd. It also applies to de Chair Avenue AND Burns Rd. Please drive according to the speed zones. **The speed limit on school grounds is 10km/h. This applies to the Burns Rd parent car park as well. Please always think SAFETY FIRST when driving/parking in and around a school. Patience is key. Thank you. Please also remember that the Kiss and Drop zone is there for children's safety. You can only stop for up to 2 minutes and can only be up to 3 metres away from your car. Police have notified us that they will be patrolling these zones for the remainder of the term.**

A reminder also that you are now able to purchase a DVD of either the K-2 or 3-6 shows of the Springwood Spectacular from the office for \$10 each.

Bush Fire and Your Home

PREPARE YOUR HOME AND PROPERTY FOR BUSH FIRES

These maintenance tips may help prevent burning embers destroying your house:

- ☐ Install metal gutter guards
- ☐ Repair damaged or missing tiles on the roof
- ☐ Install fine metal mesh screens on windows and doors
- ☐ Fit seals around doors and windows to eliminate gaps
- ☐ Enclose the areas under the house
- ☐ Repair or cover gaps in external walls
- ☐ Attach a fire sprinkler system to gutters

Things to do around your house and garden:

- ☐ keep lawns short and gardens well maintained
- ☐ cut back trees and shrubs overhanging buildings
- ☐ clean up fallen leaves, twigs and debris around the property
- ☐ have hoses long enough to reach around your house
- ☐ if you have a pool, tank or dam, put a Static Water Supply (SWS) sign on your property entrance
- ☐ check that your insurance is adequate and up to date
- ☐ complete your Bush Fire Survival Plan available at www.rfs.nsw.gov.au.

DID YOU KNOW
Not all homes can be defended - your safety is always the first priority.



In a bush fire many houses are destroyed through ember attack, when burning twigs and leaves carried by the wind land on or around the house. Even houses away from the direct path of the fire can be affected.

Look for the places embers could start fires - on the roof, under the floor and around windows and doors - and take action to prevent them.

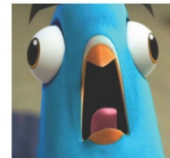

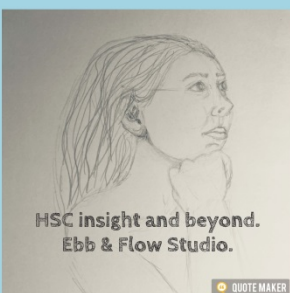
