## PSSA CODE OF CONDUCT FOR SPORTING TEAMS 2016

Dear Parent / Care Giver,

During Terms 2 and 3, students in Years 3 to Year 6 will be representing the school as members of either a Soccer team, AFL team or a Netball team in the Primary Schools Sports Association (P.S.S.A.) sports competition. To ensure that you and your child are aware of the expectations the school places on him / her, please read and take note of the following.

### SPRINGWOOD PUBLIC SCHOOL PLAYERS' CODE OF CONDUCT

Each student representing Springwood Public School in sporting events must:

- Play by the rules and play fairly and safely.
- Remain within view of the supervising teacher from Springwood Public School unless given permission to be elsewhere.
- Behave responsibly while waiting to play.
- Follow the directions of all teachers and officials, including those from other schools.
- Abide by all decisions without argument or show of temper.
- Applaud all good play by both own school team members and opponents.
- Remember that the purpose of participation is to have fun and to improve skills.
- Wear sports uniform while travelling to and from matches and while playing.
- Behave appropriately and considerately while travelling on buses to and from venues.

### CONSEQUENCES OF FAILURE TO ABIDE BY THE CODE OF CONDUCT

If a student behaves in a way contrary to the code of conduct, then the following, in given order, will occur:

1. First breach of code of conduct - Student will be issued with a warning.
2. Second breach of code of conduct - Student will miss the next scheduled P.S.S.A. game.
3. Third breach of code of conduct - Student will be removed from his / her team for the remainder of the term.

**NOTE** If a student's behaviour is deemed to be of a particularly serious nature, the first warning will be bypassed and the consequence will be as for a second or third breach of the code of conduct, at the discretion of the Principal.
