

### **VOLUNTEER ETHICS TEACHERS REQUIRED**

Springwood Public School is currently in need of more ETHICS teachers to meet the demand for ethics classes. Ethics classes are provided each week (on Thursdays) if parents wish as an alternative to Special Religious Education (SRE) or Scripture classes.

We rely on parents, grandparents and community-minded people to become ethics teachers. Teaching ethics classes is a rewarding way to be involved in your local community, learn new things and help children develop really important skills for life.

Ethics classes support children to develop the skills they need to voice their opinions, consider the ideas of others and to make decisions based on evidence and reasoning rather than habit or peer pressure.

The curriculum is fully approved by the Department of Education and has been professionally developed. Topics are age-specific and include telling the truth, being kind, forgiving, fairness and empathy, disagreeing respectfully, working out what is true, listening to others and taking turns to speak.

Comprehensive training and support is provided. Previous teaching experience is not required.
