Everyone has worked extremely hard to get through the rain and covid and other illnesses and isolations, and we made it!

A huge thank you to our P&C who managed to get the Hot Cross Bun drive done and have just finished barbecuing hundreds of sausages so that the children were fed and happy on the last day of term.

Yesterday we sent home a 5 pack of Rapid Antigen Tests with each student for use with your children. Please check their bags in case they forgot to take them out. Covid has surely had an impact on our school just as it has all over the world! As of today we have had 111 of our students test positive since day one this term. (We have 400 students) With isolation periods and other illnesses we have averaged between 50 and 90 students absent every day. We haven't even hit winter yet so let's see what the future brings! Rest up over the holidays and take care of your families. Please monitor all symptoms and use the RATs if required, we will hopefully have more to distribute in the new term. Term 2 begins on Wednesday 27th of April for all students.

2022 School Fees

Thank you to the many families that have already paid their school fees for 2022. The fee structure for this year has now been set. We rely on this income to support the programs in the school that we would otherwise not be able to afford to run. These funds give the students the best possible resources to supplement their education.

Voluntary Contribution Fee is:

\$50 for the 1st child, **\$30** for the 2nd child up to a total of **\$80 per family** (2 or more children).

The Resource Fee is a mandatory payment as the school must pay for these additional supplies for the students. The fee for each stage, which is called a *Resource Fee is set at \$50 per child*. This has not changed in over five years.

This includes textbooks, exercise books, a resource pack for use in the classroom, subscriptions to different classroom teaching programs as well as other incidentals as required by students e.g., craft materials, etc.

Statements of Account have been emailed out – please note that no invoice will be issued. If you have not received your statement, please contact the office to request a copy. Thank you.

'Intention to apply for Year 5 entry to an opportunity class in 2023' For metropolitan/regional applicants

Dear Parent/Carer

Opportunity classes cater for intellectually gifted and high potential students who may otherwise be without sufficient classmates at their own academic and social level. Students successfully placed will usually have to leave their current school to enrol in a school with an opportunity class for Years 5 and 6.

Testing and assessment

Applications for opportunity class placement are considered on the results of the Opportunity Class Placement Test alone. Students who wish to be considered for opportunity class placement will sit the Opportunity Class Placement Test on Thursday 28 July 2022.

How to apply

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 5 opportunity class entry in 2023, you need to apply between Tuesday 26 April 2022 and Friday 13 May 2022. You will need to access the online application at: https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunityclasses/year-5. You must **not** use the child's email address. Late applications are not usually accepted.

If you do not have internet access, you could apply at a public library. If you have a disability that prevents you from using a computer, you can contact the Team for assistance after Tuesday 26 April 2022.

You must submit only **ONE application** for each student.

The tear-off slip below is NOT an application and the school cannot apply on your behalf.
